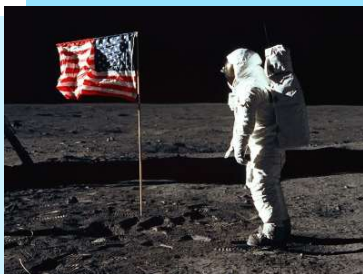


Who is more significant? Christopher Columbus or Neil Armstrong?

Christopher Columbus



Christopher Columbus was a famous explorer. He was known for discovering 'The Americas' by accident. He was looking for a new way to get to Asia.

1451	Born in Genoa, Italy
1492	Set sail on his first voyage looking for a route to Asia
1502	Made his last voyage
1504	Returned to Spain
1506	Died

In 1492, **Columbus** and 90 men sailed on ships that were called the Niña, the Pinta, and the Santa Maria. They sailed for 2 months in search of Asia. Instead they arrived at the Caribbean Islands.



Neil Armstrong



Neil Armstrong was famous for being the first man to walk on the Moon. As he stepped on the moon, he said 'That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind.'

1930	Born in Ohio, USA
1962	Begins to train as an astronaut
1969	Lands on the moon
2012	Died at age 82

In 1969, Apollo 11 was ready to take its crew and equipment off to the moon. The crew were only allowed to take 20 items with them due to shortage of storage space. They were away for nine days.
